2. Give for the Gospel (Php 4:15; 2 Cor 8:9)

According to His Gift (2 Cor 9:15)

Investing in Eternity (Php 4:17)

3. Give with Joy (2 Cor 9:7; 1 Tim 6:17)

4. Give with Gratitude (2 Cor 9:12; 1 Thess 5:17)

5. Give with Generosity (2 Cor 9:13; 1 Tim 6:18-19)

In proportion to your means (2 Cor 8:2)

Regardless of your circumstances (2 Cor 8:3)

6. Give with Purpose (1 Cor 16:2; 2 Cor 9:4-5)

WAYS TO GIVE
